Many thanks for the anonymous referee's comments on my paper and, especially, for the detailed list of relevant literature, which will be greatly helpful for me to improve the paper.

Summarily, eight problems are pointed out to my paper:

- 1. The language should be improved.
- 2. It is necessary to clearly describe what the paper actually does and what it tries to achieve.
- 3. The results should be putted into the context understandable to a contemporary mainstream experimentalist and theorist.
 - 4. A lot of studies in this field should be referred.
- 5. The psychophysical approach, Klein-Rubin utility function, and Linear Expenditure System should be described in detail.
- 6. It is necessary to explain why the utility maximization hypothesis can be tested only basing on average measures just as the psychophysics did in its sensation measurements.
- 7. It is necessary to analyze the possibility of other interpretations to the results in my paper, for example, whether random choices also fit the theory.
 - 8. The analysis on ordinal utility theory should be related to the existing literature.

I am now revising the paper from the above eight aspects.
